DUE DATE: Entry forms, fees and emcee sheets must be received or postmarked no later than January 13, 2009 to appear in the printed program. Between January 7th and February 28th, other applications will be accepted for a registration fee of \$150.00 and will not appear in the printed program. Entry form and fees are requested to be sent ASAP. The order of contestants will be determined by the time the application and fee is received. (First received, last contestant out)

Awards:

- Winners of the Relay Titles will receive Crown, Sash, Flowers, Trophy
- Runners-up in each division will receive a trophy
- All optional winners will receive a trophy
- People's Choice in each division will receive a crown & sash
- Relay Champion will receive a sash & crown

Things you need to know:

- **The Introduction:** The main purpose in the introduction is for the contestant's name AND the cancer survivor they are honoring" or are participating "in memory of" to be read. This will be on the application. Applications may be obtained at www.archbold.org or at Lewis Hall Singletary Cancer Center.
- **Winners** are REQUIRED to attend Relay For Life on Friday evening, May 1, 2009. They will be recognized and incorporated into this community celebration of life. This is the main purpose for having our winners.
- **Backstage:** We ask that **one** person be backstage to help the contestants if necessary. We ask that all others must stay in the audience and enjoy the pageant. We will not have heavy traffic from backstage to the audience seating.

 - Dress (Evening Wear) 1-10
 - Appearance/Beauty 1-10
 - Stage Presence/Poise 1-10
 - Overall Appearance 1-10
